

LUKE 2:19

¹⁹ But Mary treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart.

As we wait to celebrate the birth of Christ this Advent, our waiting is deeper than in other years. We are waiting for more than the celebration of the Jesus' birth. We are waiting, even yearning for each

other's presence in worship where the gift of companionship is extended to the fullness of our church family as part of the Body of Christ!

While we wait, we may wonder what the Christmas celebration will look like for our congregation this year. We have discovered a new way to celebrate Holy Communion with elements prepackaged for each individual. We are finding our way to a new candlelit experience!

As I prepare for a Christmas celebration like none other I have ever known, I am struck by the simplicity of the story as Luke tells it. There is no pomp and circumstance of similarly announced births of those who would ascend the throne in Rome. Yet, Christ is the King of kings! The announcement is to the poorest of the poor, the shepherds who are outside of the

city in the fields with their sheep, not to those of societal power and importance. Yet, Christ is Lord of lords. And while the angel chorus must have been magnificent, the visit and message of shepherds at the manger must have been at least confusing if not chaotic there in the stable that served as delivery room and infant nursery.

Luke wrote, "Mary treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart." Hers is a curiously quiet response, having received an angelic visit of her own; but not uncharacteristic to the one who said, "Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word."

My hope and prayer as we wait together, is that in our own words and in our own way we would yield so willingly to God's word and will; we will ponder our experience in this time in our hearts; so that we may discover the new ways God is leading us into 2021! I long for the days when this pandemic is far enough behind us that we may all safely gather and sing like the angelic host. Until then, as I ponder all these things, I will pray for you, our church family, and for the world!
